Too early for any reviews, this perennial favorite and 'Best Buy' will grace any table and compliment a wide range of dishes.

**Grape Source** 100% Napa Valley. Our 2004 Ramsay Pinot Noir comes from two Napa Valley Vineyards, one in Mukerji Vineyard in Carneros and one in the cool Jamison Canyon area adjacent to Carneros and two vineyards in the Potter Valley in Mendocino county.

**Clones** This wine is great blend of the modern ultra-premium clones of Pinot Noir-113, 114, 115, 667, 777 and Pommard.

**Chemistry at bottling:** pH: 3.78 Total Acidity .58g/100ml Alcohol: 13.71% Free Sulfur Dioxide: 28 ppm Total Sulfur Dioxide: 101 ppm

### **Sensory Notes:**

**Nose:** Classic Pinot Noir raspberry and cherry characters, with lots of earthiness and lovely toasty oak.

**Mouth:** The mouth explodes with blueberry, Bing cherry, anise and toast. Even more striking is the depth and richness of the mouth-feel, like a rich, thick, red pillow for the mouth. The wine is very fruity, with blackberry characters and a big, rich, tarry and solid balance. The oak is refined and quite opulent in its "warm" characters.
