2012 was a milestone year for Ramsay Pinot Noir. Year after year I keep trying to improve each wine that I make. With this in mind, over the last several years, I have been seeking out new sources of grapes for the Ramsay Pinot Noir. Now, with the release of the 2012 vintage, you will see huge changes in the wine due to the amazing quality of the grapes that are now available. This year, the blend is almost entirely from vineyards in cooler regions, Carneros, Russian River and Solano County along with some old favorites from Mendocino. To me, the 2012 vintage is the best Ramsay Pinot Noir wine we have ever made. It is rich, bright, fruity and has a depth of flavor that you normally only find in very expensive Pinot Noirs. Absent are all the vegy and tinned characters that often are associated with lesser Pinot. I am head-over-heels for this wine...and hope that you are also!!!!
